

TO ALL MX-RIDERS

A Dutch insurance is required to participate in the free practice sessions on any MX-track in the Netherlands. ***Licenses of foreign motorsport associations as well as a FIM-license are no valid insurance certificates on Dutch motorsport tracks. Federal competitions are excluded.***

Every MX-rider (locals as well as foreigners) needs a Dutch practice license as a WA-insurance (legal liability) for the damage a rider possibly causes to third parties on or off the track.

So therefore a rider must purchase a KNMV or a MON training license. One has to fill out the necessary form (costs € 55,00) one can obtain at our service desk. A rider can only purchase a trainings license when he/she becomes a member of our association. The amount for membership of our association is € 60,00.

A mx-rider who is not a member of our association but in possession of a KNMV or MON practice license must pay € 10,00 for one free training session (on a Saturday or on a Tuesday evening).

A rider who is ***a member*** of our association can ***practice for free***. A KNMV or MON practice license is valid on our MX-circuit.

NO KNMV OR NO MON INSURANCE = NO PRACTICE ON OUR TRACK !!!

EXCEPTION!!!

Through the MSA, the South African Motorsport Association, we have received notice that their drivers are not allowed to be in possession of any Dutch MX license. It is SMA license holders therefore not allowed to participate in trainings or club competitions in the Netherlands.
